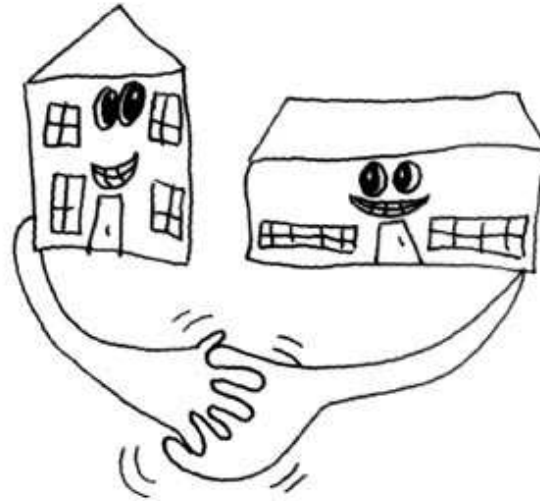
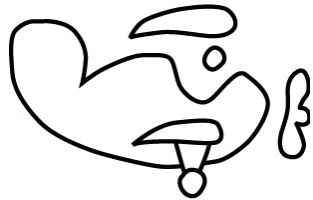


# Aims and Values

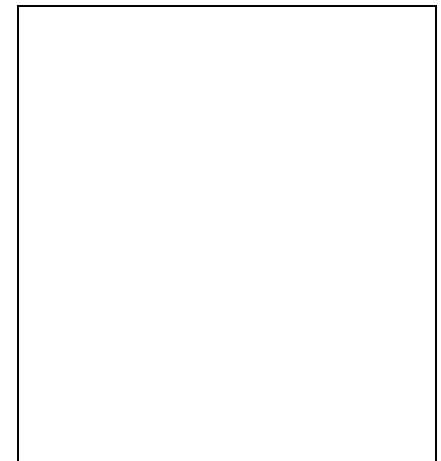
We endeavour to keep you fully informed of school activities through regular newsletters.
